Travelling Southbound on the A449

If you are travelling South on the A449, proceed to the end of the A449 (A449/M4 J24), at the roundabout take the M4 west, sign posted "Cardiff". Proceed west along the M4, past junction 25 (Caerleon, St Julians) and 25a. Get in the left lane and be prepared to exit the motorway immediately after the carriageway passes through the Brynglas Tunnels. Exit the M4 at junction 26 (Newport) take the third exit, head north along the A4051 (Malpas Road). Follow the instructions below (M4 Junction 26 to Rally destination).

Travelling Westbound on the M4

If you are travelling west on the M4, proceed west along the M4, past junction 25 (Caerleon, St Julians) and 25a. Get in the left lane and be prepared to exit the motorway immediately after the carriageway passes through the Brynglas Tunnels. Exit the M4 at junction 26 (Newport) take the third exit, head north along the A4051 (Malpas Road). Follow the instructions below (M4 Junction 26 to Rally destination).

Travelling Eastbound on the M4

If you are travelling East on the M4, exit at junction 26 (Newport) and then take the first exit, head north along the A4051 (Malpas Road). Follow the instructions below (M4 Junction 26 to Rally destination).

M4 Junction 26 to Rally Destination

After exiting the M4 at junction 26, head north along the A4051 (Malpas Road, dual carriageway) for approximately 2km. The entrance to Rougemont School is a left turning located just prior to reaching the first roundabout.
